Proposition 65 requires manufacturers to provide clear and reasonable warnings before exposing individuals to chemicals that are found by the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm. We have contacted our suppliers for the raw materials used to produce the foamy adhesive that we use behind our Aluminum products for the suppliers' feedback on the content of the substances named in California Proposition 65.

The foamy adhesive contains the following chemical known to the State of California to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm:

The chemical solvent, Toluene, is used by the raw adhesive manufacturer in amounts of up to 30% as a manufacturing aide and is not deliberately added. During the drying and curing process of this adhesive, production removes most of this solvent, leaving up to 0.33% in the final product. While California Proposition 65 requires the reporting of even trace amounts of Toluene, the foamy adhesive is considered by OSHA Standard CFR 1910.1200 to be an "article" – a material formed to a specific shape or design during manufacturing that **does not result in chemical exposure during normal conditions of use.**

Please be advised that we do not routinely analyze our products and it is, therefore, not possible for us to state categorically that our products are "free" from these substances. Trace amounts may be present in the environment, giving the potential for low-level contamination.
